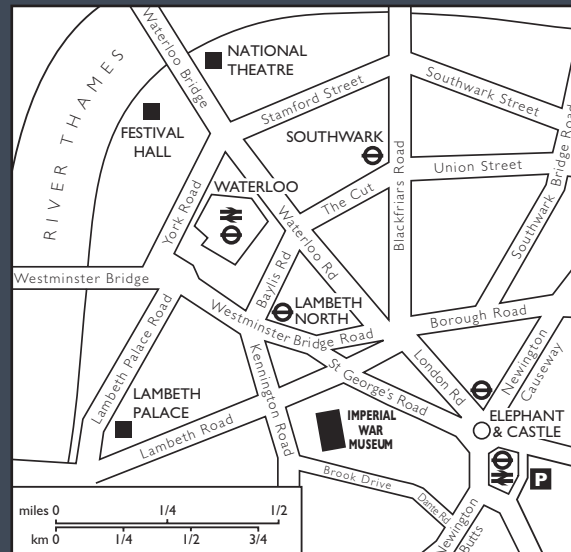
Leukaemia Research Fund

Leukaemia Research is introducing a Minimal Residual Disease (MRD) test – a revolutionary new way for doctors to determine which cancer patients are at risk of relapse and need more intensive treatment or a bone marrow transplant. However, if a patient is doing well, they can be spared the most toxic chemotherapy drugs. WOMAC is supporting the MRD Test with £20,000, which will provide 27 leukaemia patients with access to this potentially life-saving process.

The Neuroblastoma Society

Neuroblastoma is a rare and aggressive cancer affecting about 100 children in the UK each year. WOMAC is supporting a project under the direction of Prof Nazneen Rahman at the Royal Marsden Hospital. The research aims to identify the genes which make someone susceptible to neuroblastoma. A key component of the project is the use of Affymetrix array chips, which are used in the computerised analysis of the thousands of genes found within DNA. WOMAC has agreed to fund sufficient chips for one year of research, at a cost of £5,000.
