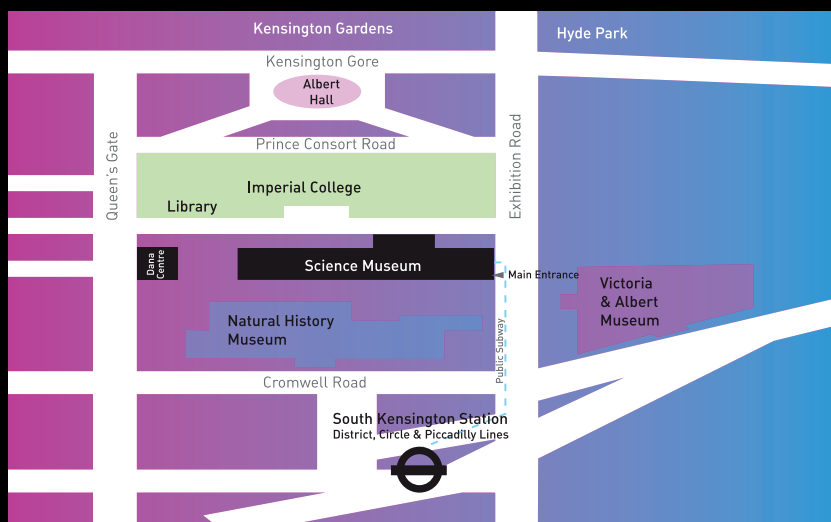
# Charities
